4. Old Business

A. Commissioner and Committee Reports

i. Treasurer's Report - *Elmes*

Comments: Treasurer Elmes informed the Commission that the report was pretty standard for the month and informed the Commission that two or three residents still have not paid their property tax, he will give them a courtesy call as a reminder that the taxes are now past due. Treasurer Elmes also requested the Clerk contact KLC and obtain information on record retention. ii. Street signs and Traffic Lights – *Kirschenbaum*

Comments: Mayor Hilbrecht on behalf of Commissioner Kirschenbaum informed the Commission that the purchasing of new street signs is in progress.

iii. Snow removal—*Lepping*

Comments: Suggest to the Commission that the snow removal contracted with the City contact the City before plowing the City Streets. The reason for this action is that the streets are being plowed when it is not really necessary. The City incurs un-needed expenses and un-necessary wear on the City streets from the un-needed plowings. Furthermore Commissioner Lepping suggested as a general rule the City not plow the streets unless there are three or more inches in snow accumulation. All agreed.

Commissioner Lepping reminded the council that the City will receive new trash cans in May, and reminded everyone that all you have to do is call Waste Management and they will bring out additional recycle bins or new top to old ones.

vi. Communications –*Hoffman*

Comments: Informed the Commission and residents that a flyer had been distributed to all City residents concerning what items are considered recyclable and what are not.

It was also discussed that if the VA does start to blast will construction of the new VA Medical Center that a professional photographer be hired by the City to take picture of all City properties before the blasting begins. The picture would be used to support possible proof of damage done to the property, caused by the blasting.
