

CITY OF CROSSGATE MEETING

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 14, 2011

The meeting came to order at 7:01 p.m. Present at the meeting were Mayor Dan Grimm, Commissioners Bobby Hazen and Larry Kirschenbaum, Treasurer Tom Elmes, Clerk Susan Dotson, and five residents.

The January minutes were approved as written, first by Commissioner Hazen and second by Commissioner Kirschenbaum.

The Treasurer's report, given by Treasurer Tom Elmes, was approved, first by Commissioner Hazen and second by Commissioner Kirschenbaum. Treasurer Elmes reported that the Treasurer's report was pretty standard.

The Commissioners voted to close two of the City business accounts, which were essentially duplicate accounts with small balances. Commissioner Kirschenbaum made a motion to close the accounts, Commissioner Hazen second, all agreed. Other financial business concerning potential investments of City funds was tabled until a full Commission was available for discussion.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORTS

Per Commissioner Kirschenbaum, the "No Solicitation" signs are still not up, and he will contact a company regarding ordering galvanized posts so the signs can be erected.

Commissioner Kirschenbaum also reported that the information for the new City Directory was ready for review, and he will pass on the new information to Commissioner Hazen for review before the new Directory is printed.

Per Commissioner Hazen, there is no new information on Security or Citizen Relations at this time.

Per City Clerk Susan Dotson, the web-site self- maintenance training is in progress.

Discussion of the proposed building permit ordinance was tabled until a full Commission was available for discussion. First by Commissioner Hazen and second by Commissioner Kirschenbaum.

NEW BUSINESS

Police Chief Grady Throneberry did not attend the meeting.

Discussion on snow removal policy/procedure for the City was tabled until next month.

Discussion of insurance tax rate within the City was tabled until next month.

A question-and-answer period then followed, with residents inquiring about the possibility of a new VA Hospital being built on the Midlands property.
