The meeting came to order at 7:02 p.m. Present at the meeting were Mayor Libby Gray, Commissioners Bobby Hazen, John Lepping, Anne Stanley-Hoffman and Larry Kirschenbaum. The City Treasurer Tom Elmes and City Clerk Susan Dotson were also present.

The minutes for March were approved. First by Commissioner Hazen and 2nd Commissioner Kirschenbaum.

The Treasures report was also approved. First by Commissioner Hazen and 2nd Commissioner Lepping. Treasurer Elmes gave a brief explanation of expenses and also stated all city taxes have now been collected. Commissioners also reviewed the fiscal draft for 2010-2011. Per Treasures Elmes, the cities fiancés are healthy and we have funds for capital improvements.

Per Commissioner Lepping, the front entrance landscaping has been completed and we are just waiting on the bill. The city has also received a bill for the snow removal and salting of roads done earlier this year from the Fenley group.

Road maintenance is in review. It is to be decided if the roads need to be sealed this year or can wait for repaving.

Mr. Hickman with OPC will send out a flyer to see if residents are interested in pest control, mainly mosquitoes this year.

Commissioners decided to have the summer picnics again in the same months as before, June and September. We will also have the annual citywide yard sale as before on the second Saturday in September.

Per Commissioner Kirschenbaum, the welcome baskets are coming along well and should be completed soon.

Commissioners decide to go with Allen Electric for the front entrance electrical work that needs to be done. First by Commissioner Hazen and 2nd Commissioner Lepping.

Per Commissioner Hazen, he said we need to notify residents not to put up their flags on the mailboxes when mailing items. The postman told him it is a signal for thieves to steal the mail. Commissioner Hazen also said we have 2 house in the city on the market; one is for sale and one sale or rent.

Commissioners will look into updating any city street signs that may be missing or needing replacement.
