

CITY OF CROSSGATE MEETING

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, 2011

The meeting came to order at 7:00 p.m. Present at the meeting were Mayor Dan Grimm, Commissioners Bobby Hazen, Anne Stanley Hoffman, Treasurer Tom Elmes and Clerk Susan Dotson.

The August minutes were approved as written, first by Commissioner Hazen and second by Commissioner Hoffman.

The Treasurer's report, given by Treasurer Tom Elmes, was approved, first by Commissioner Hazen and second by Commissioner Hoffman.

Treasurer Elmes stated that the monthly road funds have not come in yet, but he expects the funds any day. Treasurer Elmes also reported that Graymoor-Devondale did not submit an invoice for the month of August but have for September, he will see if the City of Crossgate needs to do anything to correct the issue. In addition, the City has a Certificate of Deposit which will mature later this month, the commission recommended the City keep the funds safe, and advised the Treasurer to renew the Certificate for six months.

COMMISSIONER REPORTS

Commissioner Hazen updated the Commission on the rash of car break-ins the City experienced on August 30th.

Commissioner Hoffman stated that the annual City wide yard sale was a success.

Commissioner Hazen gave Mayor Grimm the contact telephone number of a LG&E representative to call when the power goes off in the City. Currently Crossgate is on two different power grids and in some cases when the power is off LG&E can switch the grid over to the part of the City that does have power.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Grimm will meet with Councilman Kelly Downard this month and the Veterans Department concerning the I-264/U.S. 42 interchange study.
