MEETING OF DECEMBER 14, 2009

New zoning is need for the UP DOWN CLUB. The meeting for the rezoning will be held December 21, 2009 at 514 Liberty Street.

There was a general discussion period about the 264 interchange with city residents present at the meeting. Residents were informed more detailed questions and answers could be given at the January 5th meeting.
