

**CITY OF CROSSGATE
MEETING OF AUGUST 10, 2009
T. J. UNITARIAN CHURCH**

The meeting came to order at 7:00 p.m. Present at the meeting were Mayor Libby Gray, Commissioners Bobby Hazen, Anne Stanley-Hoffman and Larry Kirschenbaum. The city Treasurer Tom Elmes and City Clerk Susan Dotson were also present.

Commission wanted to remind residents that persons over 65 could get 30% off the MSD part of their water bill

The minutes for July were approved with the following amendment. Commissioner Lepping signed the FEMA for Mayor Gray in her absence for the ice storm damage refund. Funds received from FEMA will be put in the general fund and used for city beautification. The fund reimbursement has been applied for and approved commissionl is awaiting funds. 1st by Commissioner Hazen and 2nd by Commissioner Hoffman.

The Treasurer's report from July was also approved. 1st by Commissioner Hazen and 2nd by Commissioner Kirschenbaum.

Mainscape has been paid for the entrance plantings. Commission will look into what company they want to use for entrance maintenance.

Per Commissioner Hoffman, the next city picnic and yard sale will both be on September 12, 2009. Commissioner Hoffman called police chief Grady Thornberry to see if someone from the police department would like to attend our picnic. He said he wanted an email as a reminder. For the yard sale Commission will place an ad in the Courier Journal and The Voice Tribune. Former-Commissioner Allgeier has the signs for the yard sale and someone will collect them this month.

Commissioner Hoffman stated she is working on the newsletter, and Sharron Hilbrecht has been busy. Commissioner Hoffman will email Sharron a list of items for the newsletter later this month. Commissioner Hazen wants a reminder in the newsletter about the 25 MPH city speed limit.

Per Commissioner Kirschenbaum, no new information on the welcome baskets. He also has proofs for the new directory and has noticed quite a few errors so corrections will have to be made. Commission also decided to change the directory cover color to help residents know the difference between old and new directories. Commissioner Kirschenbaum also

reminded the Commission he will not be at the September meeting.

Treasurer Elmes suggest we place monthly police report on the city web site. All agreed since report gave no personal details but rather only general monthly report information.

Chief of Police Gardy Thornberry will send a flyer out to Crossgate residents about senior assistance.

Northfield is having a theft problem. People are dropping off teenagers and then picking them up after they steal things from the residents.

Per Commissioner Hazen, we still have 3 houses for sale in our city.
