MONDAY, AUGUST 8, 2011

Per Commissioner Lepping, there is no new information on roads, contracts or entrances.

Commissioner's Lepping and Kirschenbaum will have a meeting concerning a new snow removal contract for this coming winter season.

The Mayor and Commissioners reviewed the road changes for the Watterson HWY, Brownsboro road, and HWY 42 interchange.
