

**CITY OF CROSSGATE MEETING**

The new City directory is still under review.

The Commission decided to place the "No Solicitation" signs on existing city sign poles. The poles that had been purchased for the signs will be returned.

Commissioners Hoffman, Kirschenbaum and Hazen will attend the May11, 2011 public meeting about the proposed locations for the new Roblely Rex VAMC.

Kentucky Department of Transportation will send out a revised report of the proposed Watterson Expressway/22 ramp in about 6-8 weeks. Mayor Grimm will receive a copy when the report is issued.
