CITY OF CROSSGATE ORDINANCE

NUMBER 03 SERIES 2015

An ordinance relating to an unexpected amendment to the budget for the 2015-2016 fiscal year.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Commission of the City of Crossgate to transfer \$100,000 from Crossgate's general fund to the road fund;

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Commission of the City of Crossgate to pave the City of Crossgate roads in FY 2015, pending the availability of a contractor;

WHEREAS, the anticipated expense of the city-wide paving proposals reviewed thus far do not exceed \$124,000;

WHEREAS, the Commission of the City of Crossgate had previously allocated approximately \$24,424 towards the potential repair of Crossgate City roads, to include: pothole repair, deep crack repair and seal coating;

WHEREAS, the Commission of the City of Crossgate advised that a short-term city-wide road repair and sealcoating would extend the life of the Crossgate city roads no more than 24 months;

WHEREAS, the cost for petroleum is at an all-time low, thereby allowing the cost of paving material to be equally low;

WHEREAS, this ordinance was introduced at the meeting of August 10, 2015, and received an affirmative vote of the majority of the Commission of the City of Crossgate; Therefore, be it ordained by the City of Crossgate on September 14, 2015; that \$100,000 from Crossgate's general fund be transferred to the road fund for the purpose of paving the roads of the City of Crossgate in FY 2015, pending availability of a contractor.
