Comments:

- No news on the Artis property.
- Providence Point: there are multiple people in the area doing a lot of legwork to find out more detail in what's happening like our guests, Jennifer and Jackie (Thornhill).
 - o (Jennifer) The main idea on the table for development is an apartment complex. The highest concerns are traffic and flooding issues. Have reached out to Councilwoman McCraney and inviting Hagan to a conversation.
 - o (Jackie) There has been a civil suit with MSD regarding the Herr Lane flooding. They know it's been a traffic issue, but there's no money to do anything. The original plan also included patio homes and shops.
 - o (Mike Yaeger) The car count for the development is 950 cars and only 2 dumpster sites. There's not sufficient water retention on the design. The entrances look to be across from Ballard, across from Westboro Rd., and the alley behind McDonalds.
 - o (Krish) The traffic study was published in July, the numbers are from 2019 which would create an extra 15 minutes at the light during peak times.
 - o (Mayor) Do we have indication on a public meeting date?
 - Not yet, when we know we will attend.
