- Waste Management: we have let them know that we are unsatisfied with their service and we are looking at other providers. Notified them of a failed pickup and they agreed to pickup on Tuesday. The current budget year forecast is \$15,561 vs plan of \$21,000. They are replacing ageing recycling trucks with one-man operators. This should take care of the piles of safety glass issues. The Peaks reached out to ask to have their waste paid by the City of Crossgate as it was grandfathered-in many years ago. Waste Management will change invoicing monthly to include all residents including all five Kinman homes. I will be working with the Treasurer to make sure the billing is correct going forward.
  - o (Mayor) We've been letting Waste Management know of our dissatisfaction every week for months. Today, Commissioner Gerrish put them on official notice.
- The Kinman properties were included in the services provided by Crossgate without paying taxes to Crossgate as agreed to many years ago by the City of Crossgate and the Kinmans. They are not on our PVA tax revenue listing. I discussed this with one of the Kinman families. Since the agreement was made with our city many years ago, they may not be inclined to pay taxes to Crossgate moving forward.
- We should be past any need for snow/ice removal.
- For budget preparation:
  - o Snow/Ice removal (from Road Fund) \$2,425, \$2,000 was planned
  - o Grounds will be under budget at \$6,300
  - o Storage will be under budget at \$1,628
- Not sure yet on other items like Police yet. Will need to review 2023-2024 budget and prepare for readings next month
