- (Brian) Any update on the wooded area behind the church? More than willing to help with that. (Mayor – yes, have had an initial reach-out, will be handing off to Commissioner Krish and you two can work together on that).
- (Brian) Any update on the Parking Ordinance and the signage on vehicles? (Discussion about the verbiage in the Parking Ordinance and that it includes signage on commercial vehicles).
- (Mallory) Revisit with Police to ticket the overnight parking violators. Are the police patrolling?
- (Ray) The water company recently installed new auto-reading devices, The bill doubled with using less water. St. Regus has this issue as well. (Mayor: survey twice to check the water bills. If there's a wide-spread yes on water bill increases, the Commission can then take steps to address the issue).
- (Ray) Taxes on the house went up 50% - did that happen to everybody? (Yes, through the re-evaluation)
- (Susie) Where are we on the plumbing truck? (Discussion and review of history of the plumbing truck. The Commission had originally told him if he got a smaller vehicle then he'd be ok, but that's not the case according to the Parking Ordinance. So, another solution needs to be sought. Right now there are two vehicles in the City that are not compliant with the Parking Ordinance and would need a warning

to start the enforcement and appeal process.

- (Schyler) We have the construction dumpsters still in the neighborhood.
- (Mayor) We need to revitalize the Good Neighbor Task Force and be more intentional with neighbors to learn what’s happening real-time, i.e., LG&E digging in the yards.
